#### Other events in Lyme - important information, please read

We would like to let competitors know, the Lyme Regis Sailing Club is hosting a sailing race on the same day. We MUST give way to them in the harbour. After the support race, boats will be held back from entering the harbour until their trailer is ready on the slipway. Boat 81 will be managing this from the harbourmouth. Skiers can be dropped off on the pontoon. We thank you for your patience in advance.

Because there will be a sailing race and water ski race running on Sunday, for Health & Safety there is restricted access on the slipway and only competitors will be allowed access during launching. This is for your safety and that of others.

#### How to get here...

Lyme Regis is located in Dorset on the South West coast of England.

To get here by road **Routes from North**M5, A37, A3066, A30, A358, A35 & B3156 **Routes from East**A30, A354, A338, A303, A31 & A35 **Routes from West**A30, A35 & A3052

Follow signs to the 'Cobb'.

People towing boats will be met and shown where to park by our parking staff.

Please call James on 07515538412 once you have arrived at the seafront.

Late arrivals on Friday night - please take your boat with you to the camping area, and we will move your boat to the pits in the morning.

CAUTION! For those of you in large campers and towing boats, AVOID the Town Centre when you approach Lyme Regis. This area cannot accommodate large vehicles and you will get STUCK, it is also the wrong end of town!

DO NOT RELY ON SAT NAV ONCE YOU ARRIVE IN LYME REGIS, IT WILL TAKE YOU INTO THE TOWN CENTRE - IT HAS BEEN TESTED!

## Camping

The Lyme Regis Powerboat Club has a designated camping area for competitors. Camping spaces have now been booked and confirmed. If you have not booked your camping pitch, please contact Pamela 07515424248. The fee for the weekend is £50 per space - cash on arrival.

The camping area will be available from - 6pm Friday 5th June until 11.58pm Sunday 7th June.

You will be issued with a camping pass which is to be displayed in your front window at all times. You will be shown to a parking space by a member of the LRPBC on arrival, you can't choose your own space - please respect the decision of the parking attendant. Bin bags will be provided - please clean up after yourself.

## **Parking**

We have limited number of car parking spaces available - cost is £10 per day. To book a car parking space please contact Pamela 07515424248. Available from Saturday 6th June 8am until Sunday 7th June 11.58pm.

No unauthorised vehicles are permitted to park in the LRPBC private car park. Parking IS NOT PERMITTED on the slipway under any circumstances. Campers are not permitted to park anywhere on the seafront, except in the designated area acquired by the LRPBC.

We advise all boats arrive at the venue pre-fuelled if possible.

Boats needing to refuel between races will have to come out of the water into a designated fuelling area.
